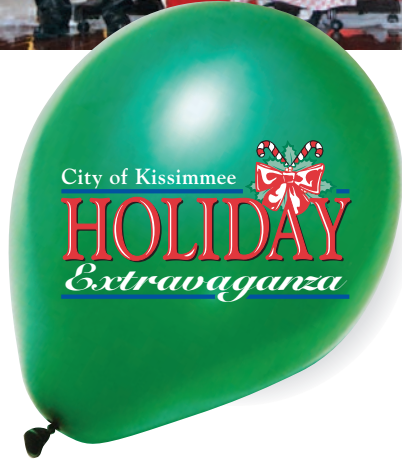


Holiday Extravaganza

The winner of this cook-off earns an automatic bid to the I.C.S.'s World Championship Cook-Off. This event consists of a free chili samples, live music, kids activities, arts/crafts and food festival. This event draws about 10,000 people.
